



Children's Acute Transport Service

CATS/GOSH Major Incident Plan (MIP)

CATS Staff Immediate actions in the event of a Possible Major Incident (includes but not limited to; vehicle accident, loss of contact with the team/team overdue, threat to service delivery)

- 1) Inform Duty CATS Consultant or if no response GOSH CSP (bleep 0313)
- 2) Start recording information in the Personal Log (Appendix 3 of the Major Incident Plan folder)
- 3) Take further action as directed by Incident Coordinator

CATS will not respond to the scene of a major incident unless at the request of London's NHS Emergency Services

CATS will endeavour to deliver its usual service but may need to call in additional resources

Do not release information to media/third parties

The Major Incident Plan folder is located on the CATS Duty Admin Desk or within the Safety Management System (SMS) Manual (online/paper copy)
